Oil Paint:

- Titanium White
- Ivory Black
- Raw Umber
- Burnt Sienna
- Arizona or Alizarin Crimson (Red)
- Cadmium Red
- Cadmium Yellow
- Yellow Ochre
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue

There are various brands of paint to choose from, however, I recommend a quality brand such as Winsor & Newton. There are two ranges of paint to choose from, "Student" or "Artist" Quality. The student quality paint is called Winsor & Newton "Winton" and will be more than fine. Ideally avoid is cheap oil paints from discount stores. They won't make a good painting!

Brushes:

- A range of filberts, flats, rounds and riggers or pointers for fine detail
- Blending brushes. These can be a watercolour mop brushes or ladies' makeup blusher brush and small soft brushes or soft eyeshadow brushes

Canvas:

Small to medium size canvases. The larger the canvas the longer it will take to complete!

Other Materials:

- Prints of reference images
- Palette paper to mix your paint
- LOW ORDOUR artist mineral or white spirits
- Liquin
- Linseed oil
- Jam jars with lids
- Tracing Paper
- Palette knives.
- Black permanent marker
- Apron
- Old rags
