Brushes

A selection of brushes is necessary, preferably including small, medium and large sizes. There will be additional brushes in the workshop if needed.

Paint

Purchased as either tubes or solid pans. If new to purchasing, aim for a collection.

Avoid the purchase of discount watercolour paints, there is noticeable different in quality. If in doubt, purchase small tubes of primary colours.

Pencils

A small set of quality coloured pencils is enough for this workshop.

Avoid the purchase of discount value pencils, they usually have less pigment and struggle to create impact over watercolour layers.

Paper

Good quality watercolour or mixed media paper (300gsm) is essential given the combination of mediums. Choose whatever scale you feel comfortable with and bring along scraps to practice.

Additional materials include sketching pencils, eraser, sharpener, masking tape (Frog tape), apron.
