Paper

Feel free to bring any kind/type of paper – this does not have to be expensive. It can be lining paper, brown paper roll (packaging paper) or a cheap sketchbook. The **smallest** size I would recommend would be **A3**. I found these A3 sketchbooks on The Works website.

Drawing Mediums

Charcoal – **willow** and **compressed** charcoal. Again The Works website has both of these items at reasonable prices. You do not need to break the bank with expensive materials (although you can if you'd like!).
