

In line with the latest NI Executive Guidelines for venues, customers who are attending events at The Crescent are now legally required to complete a COVID Status Check.

Upon arrival to The Crescent, all ticket holders aged 18 and older will need to provide one of the following to be able to attend an event;

- 1. Proof of full vaccination
- 2. Proof of a negative lateral flow rest taken within 24 hours of attending an event
- 3. Proof of natural immunity from COVD-19

This document aims to provide you with more information on the various forms of proof that The Crescent is able to accept and has been written in accordance with the legislation implemented by the NI Executive.

For **Proof of full vaccination** you are able to use one of the following;

- 1. COVIDCert Check NI app
- Upon arrival at The Crescent, the customer must present their COVIDCert via a smartphone or tablet
- Upon being shown the app, a member of The Crescent Customers Service Team will scan the QR code using the Northern Ireland Health and Social Care CertCheck NI app
  - Additional information;
    - A full 14 days must have passed since the final dose of the COVID-19 vaccine was received).
    - As part of the EU Framework, the COVIDCert Verifier app will recognise certificates from all countries that are part of this framework, along with some non-EU countries with bilateral agreements in place. This includes HSC Passport, NHS Passport and EU Passport



- 2. QR code on paper which has been issued by the Department of Health
- The same method as above will be used to check the status of a person using this method
- 3. Vaccination card with photo ID
- Note that this method of proof is currently an interim arrangement and ID must be a Driving License or Passport

## Proof of a negative Lateral Flow Antigen Test

- The test must be taken no more than 24 hours prior to attending an activity.
- The <u>negative</u> result must be shown in the form of a verified SMS (from NHS Result) or an email (from NHS Covid-19 Notification)
- We also require proof of ID (Driving License or Passport)

**Proof of natural immunity** shown by a <u>positive</u> PCR test result for COVID-19, taken in the previous 30 to 180 days and following completion of the self-isolation period

- The <u>positive</u> result must be shown in the form of a verified SMS (from NHS Result) or an email (from NHS Covid-19 Notification)
- PLUS ID (Driving License or Passport)
